Title of the doctoral dissertation: Medical care in the context of psych-social needs of people

with terminal phase of cancer disease under the hospice care. Comparative reaserch among

patients in Pomeranian Voivodeship (Poland) and Indiana State (USA).

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Key words: hospice, psycho-social needs, patient, dying, cancer disease.

Summary of the doctoral dissertation: : The doctoral thesis focuses on hospice care,

especially in the context of the psychosocial needs of cancer patients. The subject of research

is hospice care (inpatient and home), especially the adjustment and implementation of the scope

of services from the perspective of patients in Poland and the United States. The work has a

cognitive factor. It is an approximation of hospice care, including the contexts, problems and

expectations presented by patients with advanced, incurable malignant neoplasm.

The dissertation consists of four theoretical chapters in which the author analyzes the issues

related to the needs in the context of the quality of life; pain, suffering and fear, especially

among patients under palliative and hospice care, then presenting the concepts of dying and

death, including changes in the approach to them over time and the issues of individual search

for meaning in the last stage of life. The part ends with the characteristics of hospice care in

Poland and the USA, with an indication of the similarities and differences. Subsequently, the

author goes on to present empirical research, which begins with a description of the

methodological foundations. The comparative analysis consists of three main parts: (1) hospice

care in Poland, (2) hospice care in the United States, and (3) summary of the analytical part

(comparing the results). The work ends with conclusions and recommendations based on the

conducted research.

The results present a picture of hospice care based on the direct opinions and reflections of

patients, which is a significant cognitive value about the actual situation related to hospice

services. The analysis also revealed issues related to the social stigma of hospice care and facing

the impending death, which had a significant impact on the attitudes of patients and the way

they perceived this type of care.
